French Impressionist Caillebotte Gets His Day in the Sun

Gustave Caillebotte, the subject of a handsome new exhibition at the J. Paul Getty Museum in Los Angeles, may be the most impressive French Impressionist painter most people have never heard of.

Caillebotte (1848-1894) was born into a wealthy Parisian family, trained as a lawyer, but never had to work for a living. Instead, he became a painter as well as a friend and patron of other artists including Edgar Degas, Claude Monet, and Pierre-August Renoir. He enjoyed boating and gardening in the countryside and socializing with other men in the city. He never married and died young, at age 45.

Most of Caillebotte's paintings depict other men at work or play, which explains the title of the Getty show: *Gustave Caillebotte: Painting Men*. Its implicit theme is that the artist was probably gay, though it never really makes a strong case for the idea. Still, the show is overwhelmingly made up of pictures of men. Of the 105 plates in the exhibition catalog, barely a dozen include women.

After serving in the Franco-Prussian War and studying briefly at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts, Caillebotte first exhibited his paintings publicly at the Impressionist exhibition of 1876.

Among his eight works in the show was the spectacular *Floor Scrapers* of 1875 (above and top image). Three shirtless workers on their knees are shown refinishing the wooden floor of what may be Caillebotte's Paris studio. The light from the window in the background reflects off the floor in subtle ways, creating a wavy pattern of light and dark. It also highlights the sweaty backs and arms of the workers, turning them into muscular sculptures. It's one of the artist's greatest works.

Boating Party of about 1877-78 provides a clear contrast to the life of the laboring class. A blond-bearded dandy, wearing a top hat, bow tie, and vest, rows a wooden boat on a small river, following another rowboat in the distance. The scene is viewed from the stern of the boat, where the man's wife or girlfriend would normally sit. It's a classic image of the leisure class, with – again – a masterful depiction of the light reflecting off the slightly rippled water.

The most spectacular work in the show, for me at least, is *Paris Street, Rainy Day* of 1877. The enormous canvas, about 9 by 7 feet, is divided in half by a tall black streetlamp. On the right a prosperous couple dressed in black and gray – he holding an umbrella, she holding his arm – walk toward the viewer. Behind them on the left is a panoramic view of the Place de Dublin, a broad square on the Right Bank defined by large neoclassical buildings. Pedestrians and horse-drawn carriages in the distance move across the shiny wet cobblestones, which the painter handles as deftly as the ripples on a river.

Caillebotte's perspective in the painting makes the view seem unusually broad and deep. If it were a photograph, it would have been created with a very wide-angle lens. A sharp-cornered building on the far side of the square seems to rise from the ground like a pyramid, adding to the geometric complexity of the scene and drawing viewers into the space.

Along with these street scenes, Caillebotte also painted several pictures of men – always men – gazing out at the city streets below. In *Young Man at His Window* of 1876, his brother René stands at the double-wide window of the family apartment, hands in his pockets. His body language seems to suggest boredom as much as curiosity. Outside there are apartment buildings, the wispy green leaves of trees, a horse and carriage, and – perhaps the focus of his attention – the slim figure of a woman crossing the street.

Many of the works in the show are straightforward portraits of men at leisure (along with a few women, including the artist's mother). The men in these paintings are seated on chairs or sofas, or they're working at their desks, or playing the piano, or hanging out with their friends.

Two of these pictures depict groups of men playing cards, including *The Bezique Game* of about 1881. In this one, four men in suits are seated around a table covered in green felt. Another man stands nearby watching the action. A sixth, barely awake, slouches on a sofa behind the group. The players look far too serious about the game to be having much fun.

Though most of Caillebotte's paintings are set indoors, pleasure in this serious age seems to be found more often outdoors, while boating or strolling through gardens or the streets of the city.

Caillebotte himself seems to have been mostly an indoor man. When painting his *Self-Portrait at the Easel* in 1879, he places himself in his lavishly decorated apartment rather than, say, outdoors near a river or in garden, as many Impressionists would do. With a friend, or perhaps one of his two brothers, sitting on a sofa in the background, he turns his head to the viewer and, with a slight smile, seems to say, "This is who I am and what I do."

Gustave Caillebotte: Painting Men runs through May 25 at the J. Paul Getty Museum, 1200 Getty Center Drive, Los Angeles. The exhibition is organized by the Getty, the Musée d'Orsay, Paris, and the Art Institute of Chicago. The show, on view in Paris last year, runs in Chicago from June 29 through October 5, 2025. An extensive catalog, including 10 scholarly essays and color reproductions of each work, is published by the Getty.

Gene Hackman R.I.P.


Legendary movie actor Gene Hackman, age 95, was found dead on February 26 in his Santa Fe home, where he had retired from acting in 2004, devoting his time to painting and writing novels.

His 65-year-old wife of 34 years Betsy and one of their three dogs were also found dead.

I remember fondly the many times I interviewed Hackman, as an entertainment journalist, and how I found him sexy, despite not being handsome, with his tall figure and his big hands.


In 2014 I wrote his profile for the Golden Globes website, among the 15 I featured as classic movie stars, alongside Michael Caine, Sean Connery, Bette Davis, Olivia deHavilland, Kirk Douglas, Faye Dunaway, Henry Fonda, Jane Fonda, Dustin Hoffman, Burt Lancaster, Jack Lemmon, Shirley MacLaine, Gregory Peck, Donald Sutherland.

The Hollywood Foreign Press, that I had joined in 1979, honored Hackman with 3 Golden Globes, for *The French Connection* (1972) by William Friedkin, *Unforgiven* (1992) by Clint Eastwood, *The Royal Tenenbaums* (2001) by Wes Anderson, out of 8 nominations, and in 2003 with the Cecil B. deMille, presented by Michael Caine and Robin Williams.

I wrote several interviews about this excellent actor for International magazines, like Epoca, Marie Claire and Donna Moderna. See here one for the Spanish Cinemanía. As I was reading through them after learning of his passing, I found these quotes that apply to today, as he talked about *Runaway Jury*, where he costarred with longtime friend Dustin Hoffman, when I last met him in New Orleans in 2003.

Asked about the Second Amendment to the Constitution, Hackman replied: "I think that everybody has the right to bear arms. It's just a matter of how you use or misuse that right. Is it right for people to have automatic weapons or to carry concealed weapons? No, I don't think that's proper. I think the whole Second Amendment has been abused. When it was written people were still hunting turkeys in their backyard, and it was part of the American culture to protect oneselves against wild Indians, or Native Americans I should say. But we don't have that kind of problem now and maybe some of that should be looked at. I believe that we live in a country of freedom and rights and we take advantage of that to some degree."

He said about the war in Iraq: "I didn't agree with the President going into Iraq, but I supported him once they made that commitment. And now it's going to be a long hard struggle, it looks difficult, in terms of saving face, the fact that there weren't any weapons of mass destruction found; but we are there and we're stuck, so we have to make the best of it, stick it out."

Gene Hackman was a powerful dramatic actor, in movies like *Bonnie and Clyde* by Arthur Penn (1967), I *Never Sang for My Father* (1970) with Melvin Douglas, *The Conversation* (1974) by Francis Ford Coppola, *Hoosiers* (1986), *Mississippi Burning* (1988) by Alan Parker, but was great at comedy as well. There are many examples, from *Young Frankenstein* (1974) by Mel Brooks, to *Postcards from the Edge* (1990) by Mike Nichols, to *Get Shorty* (1995) by Barry Sonnenfeld, to *The Birdcage* (1996) with Robin Williams, but I suggest you watch him again in *Heartbreakers* (2001) with Sigourney Weaver. You will laugh, which is the best way to remember him.

The evolution of the gambling industry in South Africa explored

There is a long history of gambling and allied restrictions in South Africa. The revenue is projected to reach US\$694.20m for sports betting alone this year. Despite not being fully legalized, online casinos have a projected compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 9% between 2024 and 2030. The revenue is expected to reach \$563.4 million.

Early history of gambling in South Africa

There have been times of strict regulations, illegal betting, and now, legalization. Before any formal regulations were introduced, there was plenty of gambling going on. This was informal and on local, traditional games or horse races. Things changed in the 20th century, though, when the country faced huge restrictions on gambling (horse racing aside).

The Gambling Act of 1965 was responsible for banning all gambling except betting on horse racing. Horse racing was instead considered a recognized sporting event, regulated and taxed accordingly. This act was part of a wider ruling to put strict controls on the population during apartheid.

The ban led to a lot of underground gambling and illegal casinos. This was prevalent in the Bantustans – the so-called "homelands" that weren't fully recognized internationally but had some autonomy. Places like Ciskei and Bophuthatswana ran legal casinos. These attracted South Africans from all over. Resorts like Sun City in Bophuthatswana became famous gambling destinations.

South Africa began its move towards democracy in the 1990s. During this time, the government began to reconsider gambling. Discussions centred on the benefits of legal gambling for the economy.

Legalization and the rise of regulated casinos

The National Gambling Act was introduced in 1996. After this, casinos, sports betting and lotteries became legal. The National Gambling Board (NGB) was brought into being. To this day, the organization is responsible for licensing and enforcing regulations. It also monitors gambling activities across the country.

Since 1996, each South African province has been granted a specific number of licenses. Places like Montecasino in Johannesburg, Sun City and Grand West Casino in Cape Town were developed. These venues created jobs and brought in tourists and, importantly, tax revenue.

Sports betting also saw rapid growth following the National Gambling Act.

Online gambling and sports betting after 1996

1996 saw many forms of gambling being legalized. Sports betting through licensed operators became legal. Online casinos with slots and table games, however, are still prohibited in the country. Many players access online casino mobile sites based offshore.

This means that officially, South Africans can't legally play at online casinos based in the country. The loophole exists, though, so players can access offshore casino sites. Many online casinos are designed for South Africans and use the South African rand. These platforms are based outside of the country and operate with international licenses.

While the previous Act of 1996 didn't recognize online sports betting, as the internet was in its infancy, the National Gambling Act of 2004 officially legalized it. Since then, this sector has seen huge growth. This is also largely because of the rise of smartphones. Another factor contributing to the boom in digital payment, especially more recently with the introduction of cryptocurrencies. Digital currencies are popular among South Africans seeking more privacy when they use offshore online casinos.

The gambling industry in South Africa in the current day

There is a huge demand for iGaming in South Africa. New technologies have fueled interest. Some of the biggest advances that have led to the demand include:

- Live dealer games. Real-time live casino experiences mean players can enjoy the social aspect of a casino without going to a brick-and-mortar site.
- AI and data analytics. Personalized recommendations and smarter risk management tools are starting to be introduced. These will create tailored experiences to increase enjoyment.
- **Cryptocurrencies and blockchain**. Some platforms allow players to make deposits and withdrawals in cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin and Ethereum. This means more protection and security. Those using offshore online casinos welcome this.

There is increased pressure on lawmakers to revisit regulations. If the online gambling market were fully legalized and regulated, there would be significant tax revenue. The job market would also benefit, and consumers would be better protected.

Online sports betting is already thriving, and with technology advancing all of the time, South Africa will likely move toward officially legalizing domestic online casinos. The question is when

and how these changes will occur.

Conclusion: will domestic online casinos be legalized in South Africa?

South Africa's gambling industry has changed significantly. What was once completely outlawed is now a multibillion-rand market. Legalization is at the center of growth, but other aspects, such as digital gaming and new technologies, have helped it become the popular pastime it is today. Will South Africa introduce legislation to legalize online casinos? There is certainly a high demand for it. With many people already accessing offshore casinos, it would make sense. The country could then benefit from the revenue they would provide and the increase in opportunities for job seekers.


