The table above shows approximate data on worldwide cryptocurrency owners. We have mentioned only four cryptocurrencies here, but there are more than 9000 currencies in reality.

As you can see in the table, all major cryptocurrencies have millions of owners. So, supporting only one or two cryptocurrencies will result in losing millions of customers. You have to support at least 4-5 major cryptocurrencies to serve as many customers as possible.

This cryptocurrency payment gateway offers an easy dropdown option to support multiple cryptocurrencies in the pricing widget. Here, you just have to link multiple internal wallets (all of different currencies) to offer multiple crypto payment options to consumers.

3. Check the Preview Before Going Live

The table shows a minimum fee reduction of 33.33% and a maximum of 60%. If you accept payments in these currencies, you can unlock more savings for your business.
