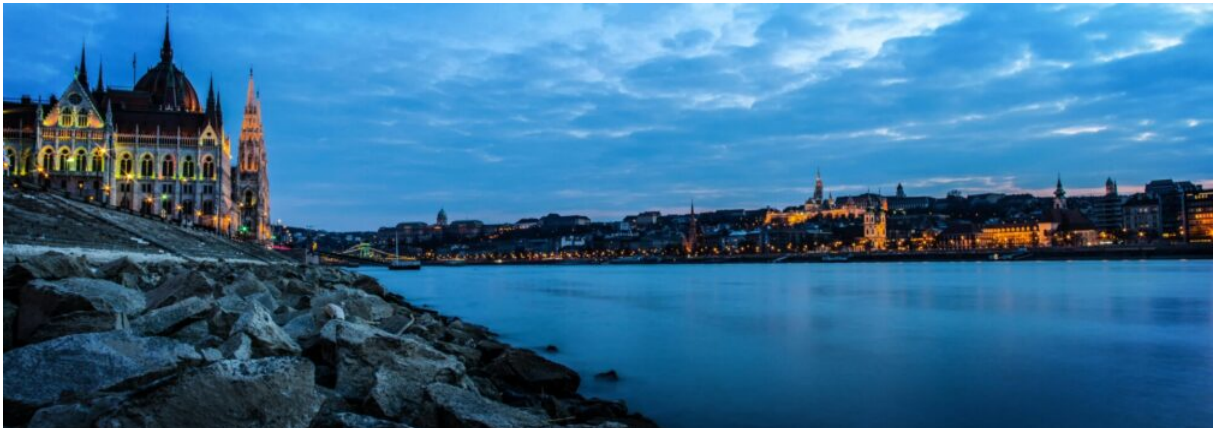
7 Must-Visit Cities in Europe for Your Next Adventure
