- -For large dogs (>60lbs), you can either give them the capsule whole or cut it open and mix it with wet food

3) Edibles

CBD edibles are a great way to give your dog their daily dose of CBD, and they're also a lot of fun. There are all sorts of different CBD-infused dog treats on the market, from bones to biscuits to peanut butter.

You can also make your edibles at home using CBD oil or CBD isolate. Add the perfect amount of CBD to your recipe and bake.

4) Topicals

CBD oil can be administered topically and rubbed directly into the affected area. It is an excellent option for localized allergies or if your dog hates taking pills.

Topicals are also relatively easy to make at home using CBD isolate or full spectrum CBD oil and a carrier oil like coconut oil. Mix both the ingredients in a bowl and apply them to the affected area.

5) Full Spectrum CBD oil

Full spectrum CBD oil is made with the whole plant and contains trace amounts of THC (less than 0.03 percent).

Some pet parents prefer full spectrum oil because they believe the entourage effect of the plant's compounds offers more benefits than CBD isolate.

CBD isolate is made with only CBD and contains no THC.

Final Thoughts

As you can see, there are several effective alternatives to Apoquel for dogs with allergies. While CBD oil is not a cure-all, it is a safe and natural option that can provide your dog with relief from the symptoms of allergies.
