Like with most treatments, consistency is key. Some of the competitors we researched say their products require shorter treatment times (as little as 6 minutes), but we did not find their products to have the same level of scientific validation. Many are also recent startups, whereas the team behind GroWell, Apira Science, were really the innovators in LLLT therapy, so they have a much longer history of producing real results.

Most makers of LLLT products, including Apira/GroWell say that they have “FDA Cleared” status, but it's important to note that this is not the same thing as “FDA Approved.” Cleared simply means that the FDA is saying that a product is similar to another product already with clearance or approval. In other words, it really doesn't mean much, which is why we give GroWell's scientific validation far more value in evaluating it. Peer reviewed science speaks for itself, in our opinion.

Design and Comfort

Another feature we appreciated? It doesn't look like a medical device. The GroWell Cap is designed to look like a casual hat and is available in a range of colors including beige, black, blue, pink and green. It's discreet enough to wear around the house—or even outside—without drawing unwanted attention.

The cap is lightweight and adjustable, so it fits snugly without being uncomfortable. It also comes with a rechargeable battery pack, making it easy to move around during your treatment sessions. You can go about your day—read, relax, or even cook dinner—while the cap does its thing.

It's also important to note that the light panel component of the hat can be easily removed and placed within most hats of your choosing, which further adds to the flexibility of the GroWell

product. It's not a feature that we could identify as being readily available in any competing product.

Their product also requires a bit more than 20 minutes per session, whereas competitors claim theirs only need several minutes. However, the 100% effective results, via the peer reviewed studies, were in fact using the session times for GroWell's technology.
