6 Practical Security Strategies for Schools

It is now more important than ever to protect our schools. Students, teachers, and school staff deserve to study and work in an environment where they feel safe, can relax, and can be themselves.

Creating a safer learning and working environment for everyone should begin with prevention efforts. Implementing security strategies for schools is an excellent way to start working toward this goal. Here are six practical security strategies for schools to try out:

Teaching Staff and Students to Recognize Warning Signs

A great security strategy for schools is to teach school staff and students how to recognize the warning signs that a student could potentially display violent behaviour. Some of these signs include social withdrawal, uncontrolled anger, and aggressive behaviour. You should watch out for discipline issues or drug and alcohol use. Other red flags come from being a victim of bullying or parental abuse and making detailed threats of violence.

A student who displays some of these signs will not necessarily turn to violence. However, they need help. Depending on their situation, students who need help could benefit from mental health services or other resources.

Whenever a student, teacher, or other school employee notices some of these warning signs, they need to report them. A good strategy is to implement an anonymous reporting system so anyone can feel safe speaking up about their concerns and worries.

Upgrading the School's Surveillance and Monitoring Equipment

To keep your school safe, consider upgrading its surveillance and monitoring equipment. If a school still relies on security cameras that produce grainy footage, it needs to replace them with high-resolution cameras. Clear footage makes it much easier to identify faces, vehicle plates, and prohibited items.

The presence of security cameras in common areas and school entrances can be enough to deter acts of violence or vandalism. But for maximum efficiency, it's a good idea to pair these cameras with an AI-powered **weapon detection system**, which can detect suspicious behaviours and security breaches. All visitors should be required to sign in and state the purpose of their presence and the areas they want to visit. They should then be equipped with a visitor badge, and their actions should be monitored closely inside the school.

Establishing a Security Perimeter Around the School

Another security strategy for schools involves establishing a security perimeter with appropriate fencing. Fencing clearly defines the physical boundaries of a school campus. It prevents students from straying and suspicious individuals from interacting with them or accessing the school grounds.

Motion sensors, an intrusion detection system, and security cameras can reinforce the school's security perimeter and help protect the campus from unauthorized individuals.

Using Content Filters and Monitoring Tools

Finally, schools can implement security strategies using content filters and cloud monitoring tools. Content filters prevent students from accessing potentially harmful online content, such as videos containing graphic depictions of violence. These tools also monitor what students are searching for and can alert school staff of suspicious activity.

As for cloud monitoring tools, they monitor the interactions of students on cloud-based applications and alert school staff whenever mentions of self-harm or threats of violence are detected.

These tools help prevent gun violence and other incidents. They also help identify students who

might be having suicidal thoughts so they can quickly be provided with the help and support they need.

But for most people, the accuracy is good enough to follow along. Many apps also learn over time, getting better at understanding specific voices. For someone who struggles with lip reading or prefers reading over listening, these tools are game changers.

Amplification and Noise Reduction: Turning Phones into Hearing Devices

Not everyone with hearing loss wants or needs hearing aids. Some just need a little help in certain situations, like understanding a lecture or watching TV. That's where sound amplification apps come in. They use a phone's microphone to pick up sounds, boost the volume, and reduce background noise.

PetraleX and Sound Amplifier are two solid choices. PetraleX works like a customizable hearing aid, adjusting sounds based on individual needs. It can amplify quiet voices or make speech clearer in noisy places. Sound Amplifier, another app from Google, does something similar by filtering out unwanted sounds. These apps work best with headphones, so they're great for one-on-one conversations or watching TV. They're not perfect replacements for hearing aids, but they're a cheaper and more flexible option. Some even allow users to fine-tune frequencies, making it easier to hear high-pitched voices or specific tones.
