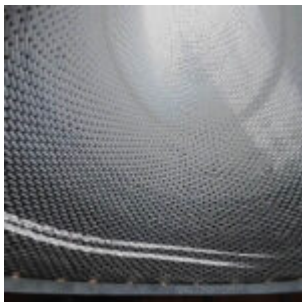
In the future, I will create movies on topics such as housing, sustainability, and open urban spaces, dealing with the human condition in the 2020 decade.



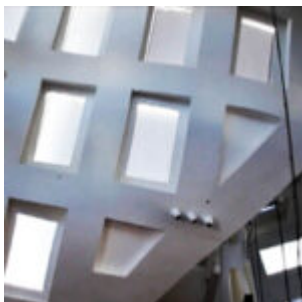

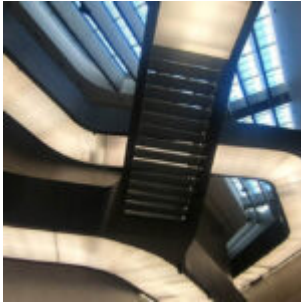
