Raphael has had Museum retrospectives at the Frederick R. Weisman Museum of Art, at Pepperdine University, in 2000, a 30-year survey at USC Fisher Museum of Art in 2009, and most recently, in fall 2011, a retrospective at the Griffin Museum of Photography in Winchester, MA.
