

With its distinctive blend of urban street dance, *Capoeira*, polished contemporary movement, and an enormous swath of gold fabric that can create worlds, the French/North African **Compagnie Hervé Koubi** concludes the four city California leg of its current U.S. tour. The calling card is the critically acclaimed *Sol Invictus*, described by the choreographer “as a celebration of hope in dark times that comes from antiquity, celebrating bonds that unite intertwined with the cycle of the seasons.” The Wallis, 9390 N.
