Checking for fair play in iGaming

Reputable iGaming apps undergo independent audits by organisations like eCOGRA (eCommerce Online Gaming Regulation and Assurance), which verify that the games are fair and random. Before choosing an app, check if it has certifications from such bodies. These certifications are usually displayed on the app's website or within the app itself.

The app should also provide information about its Random Number Generator (RNG) technology, which ensures that game outcomes are random and fair.

Before you interact with any of these apps, take the time to check that they are reputable and following the rules. This will ensure you have a secure iGaming experience.
