Mistake 2: No Clear Channel Identity

Novalis supervised salt mines. Some “Romantic”! Here he is again, hifalutin. *I feel the flow/ Of Death's youth-giving flood/ To balsam and ether/ Transform my blood.* Get lost, I think. He did. At 29. I whisper, *Count your blessings.* I do, like that precious son and grandson. Enough to cancel my mourning that brother? Cancel's too strong, but without offsetting joy I would die. Call me Merchant of Treacle. Sticks and stones. And I'm still here, not overwhelmed. Not yet anyhow.
