Dryer Vent Cleaning And Dryer Vent Repair Toronto; Are They Worth It?

Dirty dryer vents are big causes of domestic fires. This is because lint builds up in the vent, and since it is highly flammable, it causes fire ignitions. This is why you should think about dryer vent cleaning before opting for dryer vent repair Toronto services.

Besides domestic fires, the dryer is filled with lint and dirt, and it becomes ineffective when drying your clothes. A sign that your dryer is not in good condition is if you notice that it is taking longer to dry clothes or the clothes are coming out not completely dry. In case of these signs, you need to do a dryer vent cleaning or if the issue is big, an expert would recommend dryer vent repair Toronto.

1. Where Is Your Duct Located?

The first step to cleaning your dryer duct or doing dryer vent repair Toronto is to know where it is located. Most dryers have their duct located at the back of the dryer. The duct then runs towards the outside of the house to exit dirt and lint. Warm air escapes through the duct. The duct also remains closed to prevent crawling animals from entering the house.

2. Disconnect The Dryer

You must first unplug the dryer from its main source of power. The next step is to get rid of any clamps that were supporting the vent. Now, carefully remove the vent pipe from the duct. Ensure you first push your machine away from the wall for enough space. If your dryer runs on gas, ensure you handle the dryer's gas line carefully. Disturbing the dryer's gas line could lead to gas leaks which can be dangerous.

3. Clean The Dryer Vent

After pushing the dryer away from the wall and disconnecting the vent, the next step is to clean it. You will best do the cleaning if you use a dryer vent cleaning kit that comes with a lint brush and a 12-feet cleaning rod. Spin the brush in the vent at a good speed to clean all the dirt. Use the rod's end side to clean the inside of the duct and push it as far as it can go. Do these twists twice or thrice until you get convinced that the interior is clean.

4. Clean Up And Reconnect Your Dryer

After you are done with dryer vent cleaning, ensure you wipe the rest of the machine. Your laundry room is looking all dirty and messy, and if you are not careful, this dirt will be sucked back into the vent and the system. You can use a broom and dustpan to clean the room. Reconnect the vent and return the dryer vent supporters. Push your dryer towards the wall and adjust everything else as it was.

5. Reconnect To The Power Source And Do Test

After all the cleaning is done, reconnect the drier to its main source of heat. If your drier uses gas, plug the main supplier pipe and if it uses electricity, plug in the dryer's cable to the main socket. Test it with some clothes and notice if there is a change. This dryer vent repair helps you to keep your unit operating well and minimize the chances of buying a new one.
