Is Rick and Morty the Best Cartoon on Netflix?

When it comes to cartoons for adults on Netflix, subscribers are spoiled for choice. The streaming service offers some of the most popular options ever made, including South Park and Family Guy. There is already a Rick and Morty slot game from Blueprint available at LeoVegas, one of the top casinos [of the year](#) according to Bonus Finder. In addition to that there is the mobile game, Pocket Mortys, and the 2017 VR release, Rick and Morty: Virtual Rick-ality. It seems that fans are hungry for as much Rick and Morty-related content as possible.

Few other cartoons on Netflix at the moment have undergone as much cross-platform marketing as Rick and Morty has, showing its blockbuster potential and highlighting the fact that it can be talked about in the same breath as the cartoon giants. It has won numerous awards as well, [including the Emmy](#) for Best Animated Program in 2018.

The only reason why Rick and Morty isn't as big as South Park or Family Guy yet is the lack of episodes. It has only been going since 2013, and there have been 36 episodes to date. In comparison, there have been more than 300 episodes of South Park. When Rick and Morty has been going for a few more years it will be easier to assess whether it is one of the best cartoons

ever made.

Rick and Morty may have a long way to go before it is regarded as one of the best cartoons of all time, but it could easily be considered the most entertaining adult cartoon on Netflix right now. The complex nature of the episodes makes them perfect for multiple viewings, and the original theme will appeal to people seeking something different from the traditional family setting.
