

Step Up Your iPhone Security: Using Face ID to Lock Sensitive Apps

Apple developed the iPhone's Face ID as an access authentication tool to improve your account security. It uses several advanced AI algorithms to scan your face and confirm your identity. This

feature enhances the security of your apps by locking them.

You can use it to lock your social media accounts, banking apps, photos, or music folders to protect sensitive data. It takes a few seconds to set up Face ID on iPhone and activate an extra protection layer on your device and data.

How to lock apps on iPhone with Face ID

You cannot lock all your apps with one click on your device since Apple has not provided this option. You must lock one app at a time by following the steps each provides. Identify the application you want to lock and open it. Tap the 3 dots on the top right side to open the app's settings. Some applications might not have the 3 dots but will have the Security Settings option.

Scroll through the options and open the Privacy button. Some versions may show this option as Security. Check the App Lock option and open it to activate Face ID protection. Repeat the process in your other applications such as social media, banking, and note-taking.

The process may differ a little depending on the application you are setting up. For instance, social media apps require opening Account Settings while banking apps may require additional biometric settings. Note-taking apps like Evernote or Apple Notes require locking the Share button and enabling Face ID.



How to lock photos on iPhone

Your photo library may require additional security parts from locking it with this security feature. Your device has a built-in security feature known as Hidden Album. To activate it, open the photos folder and tap the Settings button. Tap the Photos button from the options and activate the Hidden Album button. This action will keep your folder hidden.

You might want to lock specific images within the folder. In this case, open the photos folder and select the items you want to lock. Check the Share icon, open it, and then tap the Hide icon to hide the specific images. If you want advanced photo security, you can install photo vault solutions such as Private Photo Vault or Keepsafe.

What about the apps without the Face ID option

Some apps may lack the Face ID option but you still need to protect them. There are other options you can use such as Screen Time, 2FA, and passwords. To lock apps with Screen Time, open Settings and tap the Screen Time button. The application will prompt you to set up your passcode using the Screen Time Passcode feature.

You will also be prompted to set up App Limits, for instance, 1, 3, or five minutes until automatic lock. Use strong passwords and 2FA as an additional precaution for your device and application security.

Conclusion

Your device and application security is critical and should top your list of priorities. There are several built-in security options you can use like Screen Time, Face ID, passwords, and Touch ID. Understand how to put Face ID on apps for enhanced safety and advanced data protection. You cannot activate this option on all your applications in one click. You have to set it up in one

application at a time and be keen on the setup requirements for each.

La Jolla's Marine Room: 108 years of Oceanside Dining

The history of La Jolla, its curving seven-mile coastline cradled by bluffs, is synonymous with standout seafood cuisine. Among the iconic eateries is the Marine Room, set along the coast on Spindrift Drive.

That location's unparalleled view of the Pacific Ocean was first recognized by Captain Peter McDowall Hannay (1872-1943) who in 1916 built his four-bedroom roadside inn and restaurant on the site. The Spendrift Inn became a Hollywood getaway and a favored spot for locals. Decades later, William Scripps Kellogg completed a remodel of the establishment that his father started. In 1941, he opened the current Marine Room. A lobster dinner and martini could be had for under \$2.

Fourth-generation Kelloggs now operate the restaurant. Earlier generations had installed tempered glass to withstand the ocean's swells, which during high tide, cascade against the restaurant's floor-to-ceiling windows—a grand show that the eatery bills as its "High Tide Dinners" held during summer months.

The view from the restaurant's window-adjacent tables includes migrating whales and dolphin pods. Recently, a sea lion pup snuck in through the back door during high tide and parked itself in a window booth, presumably for the excellent view. SeaWorld came to the rescue, eventually releasing the youngster back into the ocean.

The aesthetic is all about those views

During a recent dinner, the tide was low, but the view was perfect as the sun sank below the waves. Diners can see out, but those on the beach can't see in. As beachgoers fetch balls and parade just outside your window, it can seem a bit like viewing an art installation.

The Marine Room's clean aesthetic is all about the views. The main room is crowned with beamed ceilings and grounded with a blue and ivory patterned rug. Oak planks are laid in traffic areas. That's complemented by the dining area's white tablecloths.

A lounge offers small plates: Spanish Octopus, Japanese A5 Nigiri, Moroccan lamb, and dry-aged tuna bluefin caparccio, among others.

The meal begins

For dinner, our party enjoyed the Local Bluefin Tuna, Georges Bank Diver Scallops, and Tasmanian Ocean Trout. Among the trio, I favored the tuna and scallops. In comparison to the artful blend of flavors in the other two dishes, the trout seemed a bit ordinary.

The scallops arrived coated with a delicate crisp, the interiors buttery—paired with a sun-dried tomato salad. It was served with a pumpkin seed mole, and miso-glazed pear. The dish was fresh, both in presentation and in flavors. The tuna was served with edamame, pickled ginger, fresno chiles, and togarashi aioli. The tuna was seared exactly right, and the taste was bright and well-paired, especially with the ginger and chile. I picked up hints of the Japanese cardamom, and sansho in the togarashi.

Our sides included Wild Mushrooms with black garlic, madira and boschetto (earthy and rich), Golden Beet Salad, which had a great combo of goat cheese, pistachio, and jamon iberico, and Peruvian crudo. The latter was the standout among this trio. The tuna was served with aji amarillo agua chile (Peruvian yellow chile pepper and raw fish with spiced lime juice), mint, cilantro, and boba crisp. The hit of flavor and spice was like a surprise. We raved about it.

The Marine Room's Executive Chef Michael Vaughn recently joined the restaurant after the departure of Mike Minor, a "Cutthroat Kitchen" winner. Minor had replaced longtime French-born chef Bernard Guillas who enjoyed a 27-year run at the establishment. Vaughn's experience includes stints as an Executive Chef for various hotels, including Omni, Hilton, Waldorf Astoria, and others.

Vaughn's appetizer specials include Yakitori Grilled Broccolini, Kilo Golden Reserve (California white sturgeon eggs), and Charred Poblano Risotto. Main courses: Snake River Farms Filet Mignon and Main Lobster Tail, and Japanese A5 Wagyu Strip Steak.

Vaughn's motto: "Shucking conformity one bite at a time."

More and more parents across the UK are turning to growing their own veggies as a fun activity to do with their kids. Not only does it get children outdoors and engaged with nature, but it teaches them valuable skills and encourages healthy eating habits. In addition, it can even save you money on your grocery bills!

If you're thinking about starting your own patch of veggies, here are some useful tips to get you started.

Choosing the Right Location for Your Veggies

When choosing where to locate your veggie garden, you'll want somewhere that gets at least 6 hours of sunlight per day. A sheltered spot is ideal to protect your plants from strong winds. If space is limited, opt for planters, window boxes or hanging baskets. Having the veggies close to your kitchen makes harvesting and watering easier too.

Preparing the Soil

Good soil preparation is key for healthy plant growth. Remove any weeds, rocks or debris from your selected patch. Adding compost or manure will enrich the soil with nutrients. Deciding What to Grow

Pedal

My mother's right hand created a stream to flow over my left hand rocks, two hearts beating as one over the white and black checkerboard of the piano. As my technique flowered into something that surpassed my mother's scarred fingers, the stream trickled dry and my clumsy left hand was left alone. I got so good at playing alone.

I died on the piano bench to step on the pedal, so let me bleed onto the sheets, let me ignore my forte, so that I can become the piano and absorb the science of pain. I am talentless in art, but I am determined to at least brush the feet of the talented.

My piano teacher is the one who breathes music into my machine, as I print the pages of notes into my eyes. Musicality is a visual art for her, nothing unable to be explained in frilly dresses and reefs and chickens on typewriters. I will be the body, and she will be the soul.

She tells me stories about composers whose identity was chosen for them (Debussy), about composers who devoted their lives to loving someone from the past (Liszt), about composers who were buried (Bach), about composers who refused to be buried (Shostakovich). I listen to everything she says breathlessly, because I become the composer when I give my body to the piano. I inhale them into my lungs and let my heart pump their essence into the tips of my fingers, the bones in my shoulders, the muscles in my toes. I listen breathlessly because in that sense. I am discovering something new about the piece. Correction: something new about myself.

It has been ages since I've played with another person. That's not quite true. It has only been a few days, but I have catching up to do. My flower is green, but it has been peeled open from the tips down to its bud, and it turns out animals like opened flowers better than closed ones. I open the lid of my piano, which lets sound out, and swallows hungrily the sounds of others. I am honored that they still play with me.

Chopin broke his wrists; they rebelled against his dictatorship of them over the piano. I have been having more frequent pains against me, and my practice is punctuated by periods of silence. I pretentiously think about how it is the price of the pianist to pay, to change the makeup of their hands to protect against the abuse of hitting them against hard keys. My first teacher scoffed at Chopin as a cautionary tale every time I shook the tension from my arms. My teacher now doesn't even mention him, cupping my hands with air and telling me to stop playing.

I died on the piano with the pedal still down; piano is a lonely instrument.
