Contemporary with wry

Since founding his New York-based **Parsons Dance Company** in 1985, David Parson has choreographed an array of highly praised contemporary dances. Ironically, one of the most popular and inventive, captures airborne stillness, not movement. In Parson's *Caught*, a solo dancer has a series of leaps in the dark, each momentarily illuminated in strobe light, as if the dancer is suspended in mid-air, an effect that invariably delights the audience. Parsons has shared that the effect involves timing and technology. That same blend of technique, theatricality, and often a wry sense of humor has become the popular company's distinguishing characteristics.
