- Banker Bet Pays 1:1 with a 5% commission; statistically the safest option.
- Player Bet Pays 1:1; slightly higher risk than Banker.
- Tie Bet Pays 8:1 or 9:1; tempting but with a much higher house edge.

Variants of the Game

To keep your baccarat sessions fresh, you can explore versions like:

- Mini Baccarat Same rules but with faster gameplay and lower stakes.
- Chemin de Fer Players take turns as the Banker, adding a social element.
- Baccarat Banque A European version where the Banker role is fixed.
