How Arizona Tribal Casinos Celebrate Native Culture

People often think of Arizona's tribal casinos as flashy places full of slot machines and poker tables built just for gambling. And once, they may have been right. Not anymore. These casinos now also serve as cultural landmarks, reflecting Native identity through their designs, performances, and community-focused events. Following the establishment of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act of 1988, which recognized the right of tribes to operate casinos, Arizona's Native nations began signing compacts with the state in the early 1990s. One key moment came in 1992, when the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation stood firm against a federal raid.

That bold move helped pave the way for Arizona's first formal agreement with a tribe. With 26 Class III casinos run by 16 tribes, Arizona's tribal gaming scene stretches far beyond moneymaking. It's also a way for Native communities to share, protect, and celebrate their heritage, and this article shows us how that culture comes to life.

Celebrating Through Performance and Events

Tribal casinos across Arizona offer more than just gaming. Many regularly host powwows, cultural festivals, and traditional dance performances. These gatherings help retain the bond of community and maintain tribal customs, passing them on to future generations. Some events even welcome the general public, giving non-Native guests a window into time-honored Indigenous traditions.

Others are more intimate, kept within the community to honor heritage, promote healing, or mark important occasions. These celebrations are often supported by the financial independence created by the **Arizona gambling laws**. With legal gaming compacts in place, tribes can invest casino revenue into cultural preservation, empower artists, and keep essential traditions alive on their terms.

Architecture That Tells a Story

Arizona's tribal casinos are carefully built to reflect deep cultural meaning. Every curve, texture, and material used is rooted in tribal identity, spiritual beliefs, and a strong connection to the land.

Tribal Symbols and Natural Motifs

The influence of Native heritage is often visible from the first step inside. At Harrah's Ak?Chin Casino in Maricopa, the lobby canopy draws inspiration from the Ak?Chin Community's basketweaving patterns. Nearby columns take their shape from saguaro cacti, a symbol of life in the

desert.

At We?Ko?Pa Resort, operated by the Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, the design tells a layered story. The floor follows the path of the Verde River, while basket patterns and a tortoise-shell ceiling highlight Yavapai symbolism.

Storytelling Through Space

Casino Arizona, located near Scottsdale, incorporates the Salt River Pima? Maricopa community's basket-weaving heritage into its building shape and interior layout. Cultural artifacts and artwork walk guests through tribal stories and traditions.

Further north, Twin Arrows Navajo Casino Resort near Flagstaff blends architecture with Navajo cosmology. The building's tower and entryway represent ancestral migrations, while the rotunda ceiling and glass fixtures mirror Navajo beliefs about spiritual growth and the journey through the Four Worlds.

Indigenous Art and Local Crafts on Display

Tribal casinos in Arizona are also cultural spaces where Indigenous art and craftsmanship are placed front and center. Guests can find exhibits, large-scale murals by Native artists, and shops that sell handmade tribal goods. These displays give Native creators both visibility and financial support. Casino Arizona and its neighbor, Talking Stick Resort, house two of the most extensive collections of modern Indigenous art outside a formal museum. The collection includes pottery, baskets, jewelry, and other works from members of the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community.

One standout artist, **Annie Antone**, is known for her detailed basketry that features desert plants and animals such as panthers. Local artwork is integrated into the space at properties like Gila River Hotels & Casinos and We-Ko-Pa Resort. Murals, sculptures, and decorative pieces tell tribal stories while presenting Native artists opportunities to share their work with broader audiences.

Traditional Flavors with a Modern Twist

At many tribal casinos in Arizona, food plays a significant role in the cultural experience. Native-inspired menus allow visitors to connect with Indigenous traditions through taste, not just visuals or performances. For example, **Kai Restaurant at Wild Horse Pass Resort** (run by the Gila River Indian Community) builds its dishes around heirloom ingredients like tepary beans, blue corn, cholla buds, and saguaro blossom syrup.

The kitchen puts a modern spin on traditional Pima and Maricopa recipes, offering fine-dining versions of ancestral meals. Other spots like Casino Arizona and Talking Stick Resort offer more casual dining rooted in heritage. Fry bread is a popular staple here, served as Navajo tacos or paired with blue corn chili and seasonal produce. These meals often feature the "three sisters"—corn, beans, and squash—along with wild meats and age-old preservation techniques. Places like the Fry Bread House in Phoenix show the deep connection between food and identity. This local favorite, known for its savory and sweet fry bread dishes, won a James Beard American Classic award. It's also helped inspire similar menus at tribal resorts throughout the state.

Absolutely. Tribal casinos are open to everyone over the legal gambling age (usually 21). You

don't need to be a tribal member to enjoy the games, dining, or cultural experiences. But a few events might be reserved for the community.

What makes tribal casinos different from regular ones?

Tribal casinos aren't just about fun and games. They're owned and run by Native nations, so they often double as cultural hubs showcasing tribal art, food, and traditions alongside the entertainment.

Is it okay to attend Native events or buy crafts if I'm not Native?

Yes, just be respectful. These events and shops are often open to the public. Buying from Native artists or attending a cultural show supports the community and keeps traditions alive.

Tribal casinos in Arizona offer much more than entertainment. They serve as cultural spaces where Native traditions are shared, honored, and preserved through design, art, entertainment, and food. While these casinos help generate vital income for communities, they also serve a bigger purpose. They help preserve stories, language, and values passed down for generations. More than just a business, each casino is a beacon of resilience and self-determination; proof that Native communities can protect their heritage and thrive on their terms.





Playing Music at The Watts Conservatory of Music

"A wise man once told me we say 'playing music' because the joy of music is about play," declares bassist Norwood Fisher to a room of 11 aspiring music students from 7 to 17 on a mid-June Tuesday morning in a classroom at Verbum Dei Jesuit High School in Watts. "Music serves the soul," Norwood tells the onlooking youth. The native Angeleno Norwood is the co-founder of the legendary ska band Fishbone. Norwood's telling stories after jamming Stevie Wonder's "Superstition," with three other equally adept musicians: Jane's Addiction drummer Stephen Perkins, Delta Nove/Long Beach Dub All Stars guitarist Bobby Easton and Long Beach Dub All Stars bassist/keyboardist Ed Kampwirth.



Their impromptu jam opened the Watts Conservatory of Music, a program 10 years in the making. Though the team behind the Conservatory has done several one-off workshops with several Watts'


schools over the last decade, it wasn't until Tuesday June 17th that the Conservatory's held consecutive lessons in the same space over a prolonged period. The 17th kicked off an 8-week class held from Tuesdays through Thursdays, from 11am to 2pm, at Verbum Dei (VERB). Offering bass, drums, guitar and piano lessons, there's an all-star cast of teaching artists including the legends above. To top it all off, it's all free.

Over the last month, I spent four days watching the program grow. Here's the origin story.



Founded by David Moss, Norwood Fisher, music educator Fernando Pullum and Michael Balzary aka Flea from the Red Hot Chili Peppers, the Conservatory's mission puts musical instruments in the hands of Watts youth while teaching and inspiring them musically. The genesis dates back to 2015. Though Flea is no longer involved, the Silverlake Conservatory of Music he started in 2001 is the template of what the Watts Conservatory aspires to.

Co-founder David Moss is the catalyst bringing it all together. His inspiration for starting the Conservatory emerged after he founded the Harold Robinson Foundation in 2009. They worked with every Watts' elementary school along with Markham Middle School. Their program took students up to Camp Ubuntu in the San Gabriel Mountains.



"Watts is a unique community with a storied history," Moss states. "Four large housing projects on the four corners of Watts all being rivals is another important part of what drives me. I believe music heals and unites and ultimately I'd like to see a band made up of members from each of the four projects." The four projects are Nickerson Gardens, Imperial Courts, Jordan Downs and Hacienda Village.

Though Watts is only 2 square miles, very few LA neighborhoods match its cultural, political and social history. The legacy of local giants stretches back a century with performers like Buddy Collette, Charles Mingus, Etta James, Don Cherry, Eric Dolphy and Barry White. Other icons from the area include the Watts Prophets, Wanda Coleman, Walter Mosley and LA's first African American mayor, Tom Bradley.

Following the 1965 Watts Rebellion, a movement of artists, poets, musicians and filmmakers emerged called the Watts Renaissance. The pianist/founder of the Pan Afrikan Peoples Arkestra, Horace Tapscott was central in this. His orchestra's guiding principle was to "pass the magic" of music to the next generation. Tapscott said, "art is contributive, not competitive."

The Conservatory continues this exuberance. Norwood lived in Watts early on along 111th Street. Verbum Dei is on Central at 111th, down the street from where Norwood lived. One block south is

Nickerson Gardens, the birthplace of Top Dawg Entertainment, Kendrick Lamar and Jay Rock's record label. Kendrick grew up just south at Central and 137th.

The proximity of this greatness motivates Moss and Norwood. The Conservatory is searching for their own building in Watts. Their partnership with Verb works well now because the school's philosophy is about "being a man for and with others." Altruism and the power of education is an objective they both align with. The program continues at Verb until school starts in mid-August. Once the academic year begins classes are after school.



In addition to eventually having their own space, the Conservatory has other objectives. "Next for the program," Moss declares, "is to continue to slowly organically build and develop the program. Acquire more instruments, figure out how we can send the kids home with instruments, how to get to one on one lessons and do it efficiently. How can we partner with a local lunch program to help support nutrition for our kids? We want to hire more teachers, develop more relationships in the community to get the word out and make sure every kid in the community knows that if they so choose, they can learn how to play an instrument."


Future performances are being planned while developing relationships with local elementary schools to become a feeder program for neighborhood partnerships with the Housing Authority of

the City of Los Angeles (HACLA), the Community Safety Partnership team of the LAPD, the Children's Institute and other receptive nonprofits.

Before closing, let me share some incredible stories from Norwood and Stephen Perkins. Fishbone's roots began in middle school where Norwood met vocalist and the band's co-founder Angelo Moore. They were signed by 20. His tales touched on LA punk rock, seeing Ice T perform at Hamilton High in his junior year, meeting Jane's Addiction's lead singer Perry Farrell on Cahuenga in 1984 at a hot dog stand and how Jane's first two rehearsals were in his mom's living room. Jane's first show was opening for Fishbone. Norwood has stories.

He met Jane's drummer Stephen Perkins when Perkins was 17. Perkins is renowned as one of the world's best drummers. I watched him give drumsticks to 7 different kids. In between instructing, he spoke about his favorite Jane's song: "Then She Did," from *Ritual do lo Habitual*. I listened to it driving home. Perkins was right about the 8-minute tour de force.

Obviously the kids learning from Norwood and Perkins might not even know how accomplished either player is, but there's a palpable electricity powering student jam sessions which end each class showcasing the ongoing transfer of knowledge and energy. Passing the magic. Program director Bobby Easton says, "it's like creating this new garden where we get to plant all these seeds and cultivate it in the vision that we have, which is a welcoming, safe, creative space."



Both Easton and Norwood tell me that their teaching mixes the feeling behind music with theory. In other words, they share the joy along with the technical aspect. As Norwood says, music is fun and that's why it's "playing music."

17-year-old Jean Paul Guadamuz is a Verb senior from Compton learning guitar from Easton. He states, "My experience studying and learning at the Watts Conservatory has been prominent in my music journey. I have learned so much in such little time... The teachers are amazing musicians eager to teach us with their wisdom."

The Watts Conservatory of Music is just getting started. On August 21st at Downtown LA's Regent Theater, "The Butterfly Orchestra: 10 Year Anniversary of 'To Pimp A Butterfly" will celebrate Kendrick Lamar's record—*To Pimp A Butterfly*—with a bevy of musicians paying homage to Lamar as an orchestra. Though Kendrick will NOT be there, many of the musicians on the original record are playing. The show's organizers have agreed to donate some of the proceeds to the Watts Conservatory of Music.

TaikoProject: 25 Years of Rhythmic Innovation in Los Angeles

I first came across TaikoProject nine years ago when I took a 12-week taiko drum class, which I wrote about for *the Los Angeles Times*. I remember being attracted to the Japanese rhythmic art form because it looked fierce.

Here's what I discovered: taiko required both mental and physical sharpness. There's plenty to keep track of: correct form; knowing the oral musical notation, called *kuchi shoga*; memorizing beat patterns and then counting them out; and keeping time with the foundational beat set by the

leader, not to mention keeping in sync with everyone else.

Nearly a decade later, TaikoProject has turned 25, and to celebrate, the 17-member troupe performed at Walt Disney Concert Hall on July 19. TaikoProject was joined by the Grammy Award-winning band Quetzal and singer and multi-instrumentalist Sumie Kaneko, known for her work with traditional Japanese instruments like the koto (a type of zither) and the three-stringed shamisen.

Known for its politically and socially conscious music, Quetzal was born during the 1992 Los Angeles uprising and pushback against Proposition 187, which denied undocumented immigrants access to public services (the measure was approved, but was found unconstitutional and was voided).

Redefining the Sound and Feel of Taiko

TaikoProject, founded by Bryan Yamami and Masato Baba, has spent the past quarter-century redefining what it means to be an American taiko ensemble. Their fame grew five years after forming, when in 2005, they became the first American taiko group to win the prestigious Tokyo International Taiko Contest, besting all of the Japanese groups in the competition. The Ford Foundation has since recognized the troupe as "One of America's Cultural Treasures."

The Disney Concert Hall performance showcased TaikoProject's signature electrifying blend of intricate choreography underscored by vocals, the koto, marimba, and a bamboo flute known as the shinobue. The evening was at once lyrical and thunderous—there was no need for earplugs, but I remember wearing them when I took lessons.

The event was also a dual album release party for TaikoProject's new studio album, "25," and their

collaborative EP with Quetzal, "Concrete Saplings."

Over the decades, the ensemble has built an impressive resume of partnerships, having collaborated with Peter Gabriel, Stevie Wonder, Hans Zimmer, Alicia Keys, and John Legend, among others. TaikoProject has performed at the Academy Awards, the Grammy Awards, and on numerous television shows, films, commercials, and music videos. The 2020 Tokyo Olympic Opening Ceremonies featured TaikoProject's audio tracks.

Grand Master Seiichi Tanaka

The group has direct lineage to Grand Master Seiichi Tanaka, considered the father of the art form in North America. Tanaka immigrated from Japan to the United States in 1967, and the next year founded the San Francisco Taiko Dojo, the first such ensemble in North America. Jeanne Mercer and Russel Baba, the parents of TaikoProject artistic director Masato Baba, studied under Tanaka. Their son began playing at age six.

Taiko drums originated in feudal Japan, and were used in Buddhist temples, Shinto shrines, as imperial court music, and as a way to inspire troops.

Classes and Community

The taiko drumming class I took nearly a decade ago has expanded into a roster of offerings. The TaikoProject Academy, housed in a Little Tokyo studio, offers beginner, intermediate, and advanced classes, youth programs, and performance opportunities for students.












