As a result of these forward-thinking mitigation efforts, Southpoint Park has been transformed into a holistic waterfront oasis. Visitors and residents can now enjoy a safer and more sustainable park that offers stunning views of the surrounding area while effectively safeguarding the island against the impacts of extreme weather.

Haynes continues to invest in projects prioritizing sustainability and environmental consciousness. The Lighthouse Park Reconstruction/Expansion, a \$10 million capital improvement, will repurpose parking lots into active park spaces. This transformation will make the park usable and align with modern environmental standards. The bike lane project on the East promenade of Roosevelt Island will promote sustainable transportation options and improve the quality of life for island residents.

Holistic Approach To Sustainability

Beyond the physical infrastructure, Haynes has embraced a holistic approach to sustainability. As part of the Tram Elevator Project, an all-glass elevator with improved functionality and energy efficiency has been installed. This upgrade enhances passenger visibility and reduces energy consumption, aligning with Haynes' vision of a greener and more sustainable future for Roosevelt Island.

In collaboration with New York Gov. Kathy Hochul, Haynes, and RIOC are proactively working to build resilience against climate threats. Gov. Hochul commended the efforts of Haynes and his team, acknowledging the importance of strengthening resiliency to safeguard communities against

Haynes also seeks to create a seamless transportation network for Roosevelt Island as part of his vision for a sustainable future. The Roadway and Paved Surfaces Rehabilitation project is set to improve signage and repave all streets on the island, ensuring a smooth and safe traffic flow. As technology advances and modality options expand, these infrastructure enhancements will cater to the growing demands of the island's residents and visitors.

The grants promote projects ranging from educational opportunities for older adults to orchestral concerts, fostering a vibrant and connected community.
