<u>September 8</u> is the deadline for locally-based, professional choreographers to apply for a residency at one of three studios in mid-city (**Lula Washington Dance Theatre**, Oct 2-21), Commerce (**Fusion Performing Dance Academy**, Oct 2-Nov. 10), and downtown (**Music Center Dorothy Chandler Pavilion**, Nov. 9-Dec. 19). *Homegrown* is offered in collaboration with the Dance Resource Center, the residency requirements include DRC membership.
