3. Gambling 102

Scrap Gambling 101, you can jump straight into Gambling 102 with this one. We love this book because it outlines key strategies that you can use on a broad range of casino games, not just blackjack. You can learn strategies for roulette, craps, poker, and so much more in this timeless classic. It's quite cool that the book doesn't try to make you believe that winning is easy, instead, it focuses on reducing the natural edge that the house has.

4. Casino Gambling for Dummies

While this title might be insulting for some, it's actually a fantastic gambling book for if you are a complete beginner. The book covers all kinds of casino games that you will come across, including blackjack, poker, roulette, and more. You'll understand how these games work, what the odds are, and even learn a few basic strategies along the way with this one – highly recommended if you are brand new to casino gambling.

5. Sharp Sports Betting
