#1 - Indoor Skydiving In Penrith

The indoor skydiving facility at iFLY Downunder gives participants the experience of a freefall dive from 4km above the Earth, without even having to be outdoors. Using a powerful wind generator to lift you off the ground, you can spread your arms and legs and hang suspended in midair with the wind in your hair.

It's a cool and memorable experience for everyone and it's totally safe. In fact, it's so safe that even children as young as 3 can give it a try.

#2 – Watch the NRL Grand Final In Homebush

Every year around the end of September or very early October, Homebush Stadium (also known as ANZ Stadium or the Olympic Stadium) in Sydney's west plays host to the NRL Grand Final.

Whether you're a fan of the footy or not, just being a part of this spectacular afternoon and evening of thrilling entertainment is something you'll remember for the rest of your life. Imagine the atmosphere of being surrounded by 80+ thousand excited fans screaming and cheering in the stands as the action unfolds down below.
