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Top 8 Social Casino for Mines

Acebet.cc, best for regular play

Summary: The most free Sweeps Coins over time, plus a provably fair in-house Mines. The 96% RTP is the only real knock.

Acebet's Mines runs provably fair on a SHA-256 seed you can check, on a grid you size from 3×3 to 8×8. The value is the resupply: a Sweeps Coin faucet that refills you at zero, a 25-level mission ladder that pays the whole climb and resets, and the largest mail-in Sweeps Coin bonus documented at any US sweeps casino. That funds [mines gambling](#) across weeks rather than one night. Redemption carries a minimum plus a small playthrough on bonus coins, and Acebet is blocked in eleven states.

Stake.us, best for the lowest edge

Summary: The biggest no-purchase starting balance and the lowest house edge on Mines, a published 99%.

Stake.us runs the same Mines engine as its crypto sibling, so the fixed 5×5 game returns 99%, the best on this list. You set 1 to 24 mines, and crypto redemptions clear fast. It's excluded in more states than most, so confirm yours before signing up.

Rolla, best for a big starting stack

Summary: One of the largest signup balances in sweeps, at a fair 97% Mines with quick redemptions.

Rolla's welcome package is enormous, its Originals Mines runs 97%, and redemptions move quickly once your account qualifies. The High Rolla VIP program adds coinback for regular players.

Legendz, best for fast payouts

Summary: Redemptions reported under two hours, faster than most sweeps sites.

Legendz clears withdrawals ahead of the field and runs a jackpot network and sportsbook on the same wallet. Signup Sweeps Coins are small and the Mines RTP isn't published, so you rely on the provably fair check rather than a stated figure.

Chanced, best for signup coins and a bigger board

Summary: The most signup Sweeps Coins of this group, on a 9×9 Hacksaw board.

Chanced fronts the largest signup SC here and runs Mines Dare2Win by Hacksaw on a 9×9 grid, with a max win capped at 10,000x. A mobile app and a deep slots library sit alongside it.

MyPrize, best for game variety

Summary: Mines inside the deepest in-house Originals shelf on the list.

MyPrize builds its own games, and Mines sits with Plinko, Crash, Keno, and Dice. The Mines build is a 5×5 with the RTP shown in-game, so check it before your first round.

Sweet Sweeps, best for the classic Minesweeper feel

Summary: The only true column-reveal Minesweeper in sweeps, plus strong VIP coinback.

Sweet Sweeps runs BGaming's Minesweeper, the tall row-by-row build closest to the Windows original, at 97.9% to 98.4% depending on field size. A 10-tier VIP coinback scheme and referral rewards reward players who stay on one site.

Casino.click, best for state access

Summary: Available in 40-plus states, with the most grid control on the list.

Casino.click runs Hacksaw Mines sized from 3×3 to 9×9 and reaches players in more states than most rivals, which makes it the catch-all when the sites above don't cover yours.

A few more that have it

Sidepot keeps a small, clean Originals shelf with a Hacksaw Mines on it. SweepNext runs a Turbo Games version with a low barrier to start. Zula tucks a Mines into its arcade games and sits in the Priority Play network with Fortune Coins and Sportzino, so availability there moves as a group. Any of the three works, though none beats the eight above.

How the free coins work

Two currencies run these sites. Gold Coins are for fun and redeem for nothing. Sweeps Coins convert to prizes, and US sweepstakes law requires a way to get them without paying, through daily bonuses, login streaks, and mail-in requests. That "no purchase necessary" rule is why the ranking weights ongoing free Sweeps Coins over a big one-time signup number. A welcome balance that never refills is worth less than a smaller one attached to a daily faucet.

What no mine count can fix

Some [mines strategy guides](#) sell a mine count or a stopping rule as a way to win. In a provably fair game with a fixed RTP, your **expected return** is identical whether you plant two mines or twenty, whether you cash on the third tile or the tenth, because the survival odds and the multiplier cancel out to the RTP. What you change is the swing: fewer mines for a slow grind, more for rare big hits and faster losses. Keep the variance low while clearing a redemption playthrough, and treat

the free Sweeps Coins, not the board, as the source of any value.

Before you trust a site

A real provably fair game shows you a hashed seed before the round and lets you re-hash it afterward to confirm nothing moved once you started clicking. The Hacksaw, BGaming, and Turbo Games titles use lab-certified RNG instead, checked at the source rather than round by round. A site offering neither doesn't get your Sweeps Coins.

Responsible gambling

Mines has a house edge everywhere it's offered, and the [casino mines math](#) determines over time losing is the expected result. Free Sweeps Coins are entertainment, not income. Decide your limit before you start, and walk when you reach it. Support is at the National Council on Problem Gambling, 1-800-522-4700 or ncpgambling.org. For adults 18 and up, 21 where required, and eligibility depends on your state.

For most players the move is two accounts: Acebet for the steady free-coin flow, and a fast-paying site like Legendz for when a redemption is waiting.
