What to Do if You Get In a Car Crash in Las Vegas That Is Not Your Fault

With more than **285 million vehicles operating** on roads across the country, car accidents of all shapes and sizes are bound to occur. The statistics are frightening, with **20,000 car crashes reported** in Las Vegas alone. Not only that, but 50% of vehicle accidents happen within 5 miles of your home, and the average motorist will likely crash their car three to four times in a lifetime.

So, it begs the question: What do you do after a car crash in Las Vegas?

Safety Always Comes First

Immediately after your car crash or collision takes place, it is recommended to move to a safe location that is away from oncoming traffic. After doing so, be sure to put on your emergency lights to alert any passerbys and pedestrians.

In preparation for your insurance claim and conversation with the police, also be sure to take photos of the crash. This includes imagery of both vehicles at all angles.

Who to Contact After a Car Crash

Upon getting in a crash, immediately call 911 and swap information with the other motorist(s), including legal information, license plate numbers, and insurance details.

After 911 has arrived and the personal injury + car damage is assessed, be sure to contact your insurance company within 24 hours.

As a reminder, there are **deadlines** that must be adhered to depending upon the specific state. In Las Vegas and Nevada, it is recommended to communicate with your insurance company within 24-48 hours to avoid claim denial.

Should You Handle a Car Crash Claim Solo?

Some drivers think they can manage a car claim on their own. However, the process might not be as simple as it initially seems.

Once communicating the crash with your insurance company, they may offer a lump-sum settlement to cover your damages. You have three options: accept, reject or negotiate this offer.

Establishing fault is essential in these types of car crashes, and an insurance company could dispute your claims over fault or serious injuries, for example.
